

Review Process for Posters & Round Table Carousel Abstracts Proposed for Presentation**AIAEE Conference, Dublin, Ireland May 23 through May 26, 2004**

The purpose of the posters is to present visually a concept or idea that reflects innovative models of research, educational programming, or evaluation. Selected participants can present on abstracts of research, theoretical advances or explanations of an issue for discussion.

Thirty-one poster proposals were submitted for possible presentation at this year's conference. A distinguished panel of agricultural and extension educators at Pennsylvania State University was convened to review and accept proposals. Based on the panel's recommendation, 28 proposals were accepted for presentation at the 2002 AIAEE. The initial review process resulted in an acceptance rate of 93%.

Authors of professional papers not accepted for presentation were asked to indicate if they were willing to be considered for participation in the poster session. Using the professional paper reviews as a foundation for acceptance, no additional posters were accepted for presentation.

Thirty carousel proposals were submitted for possible presentation at this year's conference. A distinguished group of agricultural and extension educators from around the world reviewed the proposals. Each proposal was reviewed by a minimum of two educators. The initial review process resulted in a 76% acceptance rate. Only proposals that received an overall probably accept recommendation were selected for presentation at the 2004 AIAEE.

Authors of professional papers not accepted for presentation were asked to indicate if they were willing to be considered for participation in the carousel roundtable session. Using the professional paper reviews as a foundation for acceptance, no carousels were accepted for presentation.
